About Alumni Mentorship+ Communities

Mentors and mentees who are looking for brief or more temporary connections or seeking an answer to a one-off question will enjoy the Mentorship+ Community channels, which function as message boards for all Mentorship+ users to interact – publicly, through postings or private messages about different topics. To start, we have created Communities for regional networks and popular career paths. Users are also encouraged to request new Community topics and will also have the opportunity to moderate discussions if they choose.

How They Work

Students, trainees, and alumni must first register for the <u>Penn Medicine Alumni Mentorship+ Program</u> to participate in the Mentorship+ Community Channels. All users can access the Communities feature, regardless of being matched with a Mentor or Mentee.

After completing the registration process, navigate to your Alumni Mentorship+ home page and select "Communities" from the menu on the left side of the page. From there, select from the list of communities available. Users can create their own discussion posts or respond to others. Users can also see the other members of the community and contact them directly through private messaging if they wish.

You may adjust your notification settings within the Community by clicking on "Notification Settings" at the top right-hand corner. Once you have customized your settings, click "Update Settings" to save your changes.

Alumni Mentorship+ Community Channel Guidelines

All Mentors and Mentees participating in the Mentorship+ Community Channels should adhere to the following guidelines:

- All communication, public and private, between Mentors and Mentees should be strictly professional.
- Communication within or stemming from a specific Mentorship+ Community Channel should be focused solely on the community topic.
